## PROJECT ITIZEN



This civic education program is for students in 5th through 12th grades and at college level. Students explore public policy in relation to identified problems in their community, prepare a portfolio describing the problem, identify alternative solutions, select the best resolution, and formulate an action plan. Students present their project in a public forum; showcases are conducted at the regional levels and again at a state-wide forum.

Training is available for teachers, during which they will develop an implementation plan and time table to include presentation of the Project Citizen portfolio.

Project Citizen implementation training for teachers / community organization leader's can be scheduled at a mutually agreed date and location. your. There is no cost for the training or for the textbooks, but pre-registration is required.
